Uniform Policy

Tarporley CE Primary School UNIFORM POLICY

Introduction

The school colours are red and grey and we encourage all pupils to adhere to this, preferably wearing the items of school uniform stated below:

- Red sweat shirt or cardigan bearing the 'Pear Tree' logo (recommended but optional)
- Grey or black trousers or shorts
- Grey or black skirt or pinafore dress
- White or red polo shirt bearing the logo or plain
- Red and white gingham dress may be worn in warmer weather (optional)
- Black or red fleece (optional)

Footwear

- Black, Red or dark coloured shoes.
- White, black or red sensibly fastened sandals may be worn with socks in the summer months.
- Trainers and high heeled shoes are not appropriate for school wear and should not be worn. Pupils may bring a change of footwear for outside play

Suppliers

Items of uniform are available from School Style through the school office

Make up and jewellery is not allowed in school. Basic stud or sleeper earrings may be worn.

PE and Games

For indoor lessons red t-shirts, black / navy shorts, black pumps.

For outdoor lessons the appropriate kit should be worn -

Football, Rugby and Hockey:- PE kit, football boots or strong training shoes. Shin pads must be worn for football. Mouthguards and shin pads must be worn for hockey.

Netball, rounders, cricket and athletics: black / navy shorts, red t-shirt and training shoes.

For outdoor lessons during cold weather, dark coloured track suit bottoms and school jumper may be worn.

Pupils with long hair should have it securely tied back.

In the interests of safety, stud ear rings are the only acceptable type during PE/Games lessons and should be covered with sticking plaster. Rings, necklaces, bracelets and chains are not appropriate.

Pre Loved Shop

At the main entrance of school you can find our Pre Loved Uniform Shop. If you have any unwanted school uniform of good condition please drop off at the collection point in the front entrance. The shop is open during the school day and on set days in the summer holidays. All uniform can be collected for free with a voluntary donation of £1 per item for those who are able to. If you are unable to find an item for example a size please ask the school office. Thank you to all that donate and to our group on parents from our PTA who organise the shop and sort through donations .

School Bags

Children in Reception are given a free expandable school book bag from the PTA when they start school. We ask that all KS1 children only use this book bag due to limited storage in school. Additional bags can be purchased on the School Style Website.

KS2 children can use a bag of the same size as school book bag. Size 11" (h) x 14.5" (w) x 2.5" (d)
