#### Homework

Expected homework in KSI is reading. Please read as often as possible. Focus on encouraging their prosody (fluency) so they do not sound like robots and their comprehension. There are lots of helpful strategies in the English curriculum page on our website and on our class pages.

Year I children will bring home a different Little Wandle book each Thursday to read at least 4 times over the week.

Year 2 children will bring home a colour banded book. Once they have read this book 4 times they may swap it for a new one. We remind children regularly to change books if they need to. However, if you notice that they haven't changed their book when they need to, please let us know.

There will be a menu of **optional homework tasks** on the class webpages. Activities are linked to our learning in class so it is a great way to deepen their understanding of the subjects we are covering. Please encourage children to bring in any optional homework that they complete so that it can be celebrated in class.

### YI Phonics Screening Check

This will be happening in June. All the information you need is on our class pages.

#### Y2 SATs

This is an optional testing format that we will use as part of our end of year assessment; the difference to previous years is that we do not have to formally send results to the local authority. Children will complete the reading and maths assessments to support our other assessments for the end of the year. We will keep them very low key with the emphasis on building a concrete picture of what your child knows and can do and to pave the way for their KS2 journey.
